Introduction

espol[™] 12.01 is a pre-accelerated orthophthalic polyester resins which rapidly wets out reinforcements. It is a generalpurpose resin and has been specifically designed for non-critical and industrial applications. It is not suitable for boat construction, chemical resistance or mouldings in contact with food products.

Applications

espol™ 12.01 is designed for hand laminating, spray up & casting applications, it can be used with all types of E-glass such as chopped strand mat, woven roving and multi axial.

Formulation

espol™ 12.01 should be allowed to attain workshop temperature (25°C - 30°C) before use. Stir well by hand, or with a low shear mixer to avoid aeration, and then allow to stand to regain thixotropy. espol™ 12.01 requires the addition of catalyst to start the curing reaction.

The recommended catalyst is MEKP (50%) which should be added to the resin at 1 - 2% and thoroughly incorporated into the resin, using a low shear mechanical stirrer where possible.

Post Curing

Satisfactory laminates for many applications can be made from espol[™] 12.01 by curing at workshop temperature (25°C). For optimum properties, however, laminates should be post-cured before being put into service. The laminate should be allowed to cure for 24 hours at 25°C, and then be oven cured for a minimum of 6 hours 80°C.

Storage

espol[™] 12.01 should be stored between 5°C and 25°C in the original, unopened container in a dry, well ventilated place. Protect from freezing and direct sunlight. Avoid contact with oxidising agents. If stored outside of these recommendations, shelf life will be significantly reduced.

Packaging

espol[™] 12.01 is available in 35kg, 220kg and bulk containers.
